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GENERAL RULES

1. Registration fee per student per event is Rs. 150/-.
2. Only Under Graduate IT students can participate in technical events and UG/PG students of any disciplines can participate in non-technical events.
3. **Only girl students can take part in the event.** Maximum two teams per college per event can participate.
4. Participants or colleges are required to submit the registration entries through the link given below.

5. The participants must reach to registration counter at 8:30 a.m. sharp on the day of the event.
6. Participant themselves have to report their presence on the day of the event immediately as they reach to the event spot.
7. One student can participate in multiple events based on the timing of the events.
8. All participants must report at least 15 minutes before the event start time.
9. The challenges must be completed within the given time limit.
10. Name once registered will not be changed or cancelled.
11. Students have to keep their college I-Card with them compulsorily.
12. Organizers reserve all the rights for the event.
13. Refreshment Coupons will be issued to the participants at the day of the event during reporting process.
14. The decision of Judges shall be final and binding in all the events.
15. Winners will be honored with Awards and all participants will be given certificates.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. The Event is only for the girl candidates.
2. Each team must have 2 Participants. Only Clue Crusade can have 4 participants.
3. Payment can be made either online or offline (on the day of event). On the day of event payment is applicable to offline payment only).
4. In case of online payment, screenshot image of the payment receipt must be uploaded during registration form filling through Google form.

5. Any standard Python version available at the venue must be used.
6. The use of internet is strictly prohibited during the event. Use of pre-written code, AI tools, or external help is not allowed.
7. You can use text editors like VS Code or Text Editor (gedit) for coding.
8. Evaluation is based on logic, code cleanliness, time and output format.
9. If participant require any hint from supervisor or coordinator it cost negative 5 points.
10. You can use hint only once.

3. Site – समर (Web Application Development)

Rules:

1. The event is team-based (maximum 2 members per team).
2. Under Graduate Third Year and Second Year students can participate in this event.
3. Maximum two teams per college can participate in the event.
4. Participants can use technologies like HTML, CSS, Bootstrap, JS, jQuery, AJAX, PHP, ASP.NET, MERN stack etc.
5. Participants are allowed to use AI tools (such as AI website builders, AI code generators, or AI design assistants) to support the design and development process.
6. The website must be completed within 2 hours.
7. The problem statement will be announced at the beginning of the event.
8. The website must be functional, responsive, and user-friendly.

9. Participants must clearly understand and explain their website structure, features, and AI usage during evaluation.
10. Blind copy-paste from AI outputs without understanding will create negative impact on evaluation.
11. The final website must include original customization, even if AI tools are used.
12. Internet access is permitted only for AI tools and resources approved by the organizers.
13. The decision of the judging panel shall be final and binding.

4. Tech – प्रज्ञा (IT Quiz)

Rules:

1. The event is team-based, must consist of 2 participants.
2. The quiz will be conducted in three rounds.
3. Round-wise Rules

Round 1: Aptitude Round

This round will consist of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs).

Questions will cover:

Logical reasoning, Quantitative aptitude, Basic IT and general knowledge,

Based on the scores, only the 70% of total teams will qualify for the Second Round.

Round 2: Timer Round

Each team have questions and they have to define answer within given time

After evaluation, only the top 5 teams will qualify for the Final Round.

Round 3: Buzzer Round (Final): This will be a fast-paced buzzer round.

1. Questions will be asked to all teams.
2. The team pressing the buzzer first will get the chance to answer.
3. Negative marking may apply for incorrect answer.
4. Final ranking (1st, 2nd, 3rd) will be decided based on scores in this round.

5. **Tie-Breaker Rule:** In case of a tie at any stage, a tie-breaker question will be conducted.
6. The Quiz Master's decision in tie-break situations will be final.

4. Language: Hindi, English and Gujarati language is allowed; subtitles are recommended.
5. Originality: Content must be original and created specifically on the topic given on the spot for this event only.
6. Content Restrictions:

 - (ii) No promotion of violence, hate speech, or illegal activities
7. Editing Tools: Any editing software or mobile app can be used.
8. Watermark: College watermark/logo is allowed (as per organizer's instructions).
9. Submission: Reel must be submitted via Google Drive / from link given by organizer.
10. File name format: ShortCollegeName_ParticipantName.
11. Deadline: Before 01:00 PM, Late submissions will not be accepted.
12. Disqualification: if
 - (i) Content found to be AI Based.
 - (ii) Video Made outside college campus would not be considered.
13. Judge's decision will be considered as final.
14. Themes will be given on the day of the event on the spot.

10. Submission of the AI Usage Declaration is mandatory.
